Reach & Substances of very high concern

Superior Sections obligation under REACH and Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC).

“Superior Sections does not currently manufacture nor import any chemical substances into the EU on their own or in articles in quantities of 1 tonne or more per year. In addition, imported articles do not contain chemical substances intended to be released during the normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of the product's use as defined by the REACH regulation and existing guidance. Thus, Superior Sections does not currently have a REACH obligation to pre-register substances.”



Additional in accordance with the requirements laid down by REACH directive 1907/2006/EC we confirm that none of the items we supply contain SVHCs in concentrations greater than 0.1% (w/w)

- a) Superior Sections confirm that we understand our obligation under REACH.
- b) In the event of any products used are supplied from outside of the European Union/European Economic areas , We will ensure that we will act accordingly by nominating a representative from Superior Sections to carry out all required obligations of an importer such as pre-resignation and registration in accordance with (EC No 1907/2006).
- c) We confirm that we or an any of our suppliers within the supply chain will register all identified substances under (EC No 1907/2006) with the European Chemicals Agency for the uses that are required by the company operating within Europe.
- d) We can confirm that after investigations with our suppliers, we do not currently supply any products that require reporting under the REACH regulations (EC No1907/2006).
