Superior Sections obligation under REACH and Substances of Very High Concerns (SVHC)

"Superior Sections does not currently manufacture nor import any chemical substances into the EU on their own or in articles in quantities of 1 tonne or more per year. In addition, imported articles do not contain chemical substances intended to be released during the normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of the product's use as defined by the REACH regulation and existing guidance. Thus, Superior Sections does not currently have a REACH obligation to pre-register substances."



Additional in accordance with the requirements laid down by REACH directive 1907/2006/EC we confirm that none of the items we supply contain SVHCs in concentrations greater than 0.1% (w/w)

- a) We Superior Sections, the supplier, confirm that we understand our obligation under REACH.
- b) In case the products Supplied from outside the of the European Union / European Economic area, we will ensure that no Superior Sections business needs to act as importer under REACH e.g. by nominating an only representative will carry out all obligations of importer such as pre-resignation and registration.
- c) We confirm that we or an actor further up the supply chain will register all pre-registered substances with the European Chemicals Agency for the uses to require by any Superior Sections Business operating in Europe.
- d) We can confirm that after investigations in 2009 with our suppliers we do not supply any products that are reportable under the REACH regulation (EC No 1907/2006)
